305.10 PURPOSE

LNRA will develop and maintain an Information Technologies Policy and Procedures Manual to ensure that LNRA's Information Technology Systems are managed to provide reliable services while safeguarding LNRA's data, the confidentiality of LNRA customer information, and that LNRA data is maintained in a manner that allows for secure archiving and records accessibility.
