### Summary

The incumbent of this position is primarily responsible for assisting in the duties required to operate and maintain dam and spillway. Is a temporary summer position.

**Essential Duties and Responsibilities** include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

Assist in performing all yard work including mowing, edging, digging, sweeping, trimming trees, plants, and shrubs, and fence repair.

Perform routine maintenance and repairs to existing buildings, machinery and equipment.

Perform rough carpentry and painting work.

Display emotional maturity, good moral character and positive attitude.

Assist LNRA personnel as needed.

Comply with LNRA Safety Manual.

While performing the duties of this Job, the employee is regularly required to stand, walk, use hands to finger, handle, or feel; reach with hands and arms and talk or hear. The employee is occasionally required to walk and climb or balance. The employee must frequently lift and/or move up to 50 pounds on a daily basis in order to repair and service pumps, motors, and machinery. The employee must be capable of climbing a ladder to a minimum of 50 feet; climbing a minimum of one flight of stairs on an intermittent basis; and open and close wire and metal gates. The employee must be capable of going into tunnels, confined spaces, and high places over running water. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception and ability to adjust focus.

**Work Environment**

The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly exposed to wet and/or humid conditions; moving mechanical parts; high, precarious places; outside weather conditions; extreme cold and extreme heat. The employee is occasionally exposed to fumes or airborne particles, toxic or caustic chemicals, and risk of electrical shock. The noise level in the work environment is usually loud.

**Tools and Equipment Used**

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently required to operate the following equipment: Automobile, light trucks and trailers, testing equipment, computer calculator, copy machine, telephone, pager, two-way radio, gages, meters and levels, hand and power tools, welding equipment, lawn care equipment.
